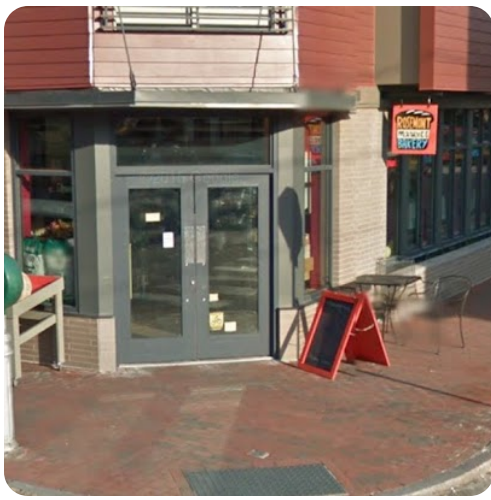


Portland Farmers' Market
